## **OUR BELIEFS**

- **God** eternally exists, one God, yet three Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- **Jesus** is fully God and fully man. He lived a sinless life and offered Himself as a substitutionary sacrifice for the sins of man. He was buried and rose again to show God was satisfied with His atonement.
- The **Bible** is the special revelation of God to man. It is the authority for the believer's faith and life and is sufficient to meet every spiritual need.
- The **Masoretic Text** and the **Textus Receptus** are God's inerrant, infallible Word.
- The **King James Version** is the best translation available for English speaking people.
- **Man** is born with a sin nature, chooses to commit sin, and is completely helpless to rectify his sinfulness. Eternal damnation in Hell is the destiny of every man who perishes without Christ.
- Salvation is the gift of eternal life from God to all who believe on Jesus.
- Man receives salvation when he turns from everything in which he is trusting and puts his **faith** in Christ alone.
- The salvation of the believer is eternally **secure** because it rests in the power and promise of God.
- Assurance of salvation is only sure when founded on the promises of God.
- God wills that **all men be saved**, but He will not force any to believe the Gospel.
- The teachings of **Calvinism** and **Arminianism** are wrong.
- The **church** is God's organism to carry out the Great Commission. It keeps two ordinances, the **Lord's Table** and **Baptism**.
- The **sign gifts** experienced by the early church have ceased.
- The church is separate from Israel.
- All believers will be raptured before the **Tribulation** and Millennium.
- Christ will reign on earth during the **Millennium**.
- **Unity** with other believers is to be superintended by the Word of God.
- **Separation** from sin and error in personal and ecclesiastical spheres is essential.
- Charismatic, ecumenical, and liberal beliefs are erroneous.
